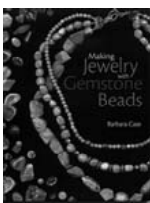

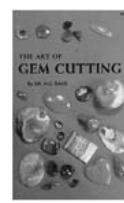

Simply put, this is the best book I have ever come upon on the subject of flint knapping. John reviews many different techniques. He looks at both the traditional methods as well as the newer techniques.



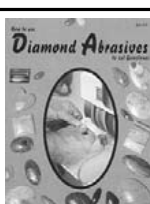

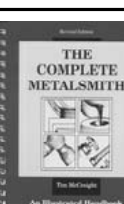

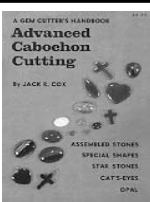
